We are approaching the annual SkillsUSA Colorado State Leadership and Skills Conference (SLSC). As you prepare to register for the state championships, please read the following information carefully, as it contains all the information you need to register your students for this year's conference.

Conference registration fee: \$135 per student, \$125 per advisor/chaperone, \$30 models, FREE per parent or advisor observer (no lunch included in this option). There is an additional materials fee of \$200 per team for TeamWorks event.

This Year:

- **Welding Sculpture** – In 2023, SkillsUSA added an onsite welding aspect to the Welding Sculpture competition. For SLSC 2025, Colorado SkillsUSA will not require this for the Welding Sculpture event, however, the student who advances to the NLSC will be required to weld onsite in Atlanta using one of the following processes: GMAW, SMAW, GTAW, FCAW, PAC, OFC.
- **Resumes** – All students will be required to upload a resume no later than Friday, March 28, 2025, at 11:59 pm MDT. Failure to do so will result in a 10-point penalty. When students upload their resume, please name it "Your competition. Your Name." Click this link to upload a resume', [DropBox](#)
- **Transportation** – Transportation from your hotel to the convention center will **not** be provided. Transportation will be provided from the Pueblo Convention Center to Pueblo Community College on April 9th & 10th.
- **Hotel** – There is not a central hotel this year; chapters may stay at any hotel in the Pueblo area. The advisor is responsible for booking and paying for the hotel. Advisors may negotiate pricing and/or use rewards.

Online Testing

- SkillsUSA Colorado will be conducting online contest testing prior to the State Leadership and Skills Conference.
- The testing window is March 10 – 21, 2025, at 5:00 pm MST.
 - All tests will be administered by a proctor at the school. The proctor cannot be the chapter advisor but can be another teacher or administrator.
 - Testing date(s), proctor name, and title must be submitted to monica.buckley@cccs.edu Friday, March 3, 2025.
- Detailed information regarding online testing will be released Friday, February 28, 2025
- When registering students, it is imperative that a valid individual email address is listed for each student. Do not duplicate email addresses.
- All testing will be conducted online through the Championship Hub.
 - Testing includes both the skill-specific test and the Professional Development Test (PDT).
 - Each contestant is required to take a Professional Development Test (PDT). The results will be added to their total overall score within their respective contests. The number of points allowed will not exceed 5% of the total possible points. This will also apply at the National Leadership and Skills Conference.

Special Accommodations

Clothing Requirement

Black pants/skirt, white dress shirt & tie or blouse, or white polo shirt are the minimum dress requirements for the opening and closing ceremonies. Students not in proper attire may not participate in conference activities, including testing, competitive events, and award ceremonies. Students who are not in appropriate attire **will not be allowed on stage** to receive awards at the awards ceremony.

- For Wednesday competition: Each student and advisor will receive a SkillsUSA Colorado t-shirt. This is the official competition shirt for all competitive events only on Thursday, April 10th. All may wear this shirt with clean, hole-free jeans and clean, casual, or safety shoes (as the contest requires) on Wednesday only. All shoes must be a closed-toe and closed heel.

The following should not be worn to any activity:

- Clothing and accessories which are sexually suggestive, which advertise drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products, or display profanity.
- See-through, tight-fitting, spaghetti straps, strapless, extremely short, or low-cut blouses/tops/dresses/ skirts.
- Pants or skirts that are worn below the hip bone; no undergarments may be showing.
- Spandex, leggings, stirrup pants, leotards, short shorts, cutoffs, or pajamas. If leggings are worn, shorts/skirt/dress must be an appropriate length over the leggings.
- Clothing that is stained, torn, or ripped.
- Bare feet.

Contest Rules/Technical Standards

The Official SkillsUSA Championship Technical Standards will guide all contests. All contest rules shall be as stated in the SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards unless an exception has been made in the Colorado General Rules and Regulations. Contestants will be removed from competition if proper training has not been provided and/or they are using the equipment in an unsafe manner.

The decisions of the judges will be final. The SkillsUSA Colorado State Advisor and/or the State Conference Grievance form will be available at the SkillsUSA Colorado conference headquarters or this [link](#). The judges are not obligated to award first, second, or third place winners if, in their opinion, performances are below acceptable standards.

For any skills contest that has only one school competing, the regional results may be certified as the official state result at the discretion of the State Director. Select contests can be certified as the "state contest" if a) only one region in the entire state has a qualified finisher in that category, and b) there is demonstrated proof that the winners of the said contest have participated in a state-level-quality contest.
